Patrizia Cigna was born in Volterra (Pisa). She was a student of Jolanda Meneguzzo and received her diplom in singing from the State Music Conservatory "Luigi Cherubini" in Florence with top marks, cum laude and a special mention under the guidance of Maria Grazia Germani.
